Introducing the Plas Menai Health Centre Voluntary Transport Scheme – UPDATE!!

The Plas Menai Voluntary Transport Scheme, introduced by the GP Partners to help those patients who were most impacted by the closure of the Llys Meddyg Surgery in Penmaenmawr is now active.....

Launched...!

Our first patient to use the Voluntary Transport Scheme attended the Health Centre last week, supported by one of our Voluntary Drivers Chris Barton. 'How good is this!!' said Eunice Jones who attended to see both a Doctor and nurse...avoiding the need for them to travel to her for a home visit. The first patient of many we hope who elect to apply to the scheme.

How does the scheme work?

Patients who wish to be considered for the scheme need to register specifically to the scheme. This can be done in a number of ways:

- ✓ You can register through your GP – next time you meet with them and wish to be considered for the scheme please ask for a registration form;
- ✓ Through a health professional or social services – if you are currently being seen by a health professional [such as a district nurse or health visitor] or the social services then please ask them if they would support your registration and then complete the registration forms that can be found on our website at www.plasmenaihealthcentre.co.uk
- ✓ Through a family member or friend [with the patients knowledge and consent] – to do this, you can have your family member or friend complete the registration and submit it to the health centre on your behalf;
- ✓ Personally – you can complete the registration form yourself and submit it to the health centre.

Registering for the Scheme

Once we receive a Voluntary Transport Scheme Registration Request we will assess the reasons why you are making the request. If we feel the reasons fall within the aims of the scheme then we will contact you and place you onto the register. If we feel your reasons fall outside of what the health centre [GP Partners] believe to be appropriate for the scheme then we will contact you to inform you of the decision. You can appeal the decision and details of how you can appeal will be available on our website at www.plasmenaihealthcentre.co.uk
